After so many months, it is with great relief that we have been able to open our doors to you again. Thank you for your patience during the past months, and thank you to our staff members who made sure that your needs were met through rain, shine and snow!

The Township Board is pleased to announce that the Community Room will be used by Calhoun County Senior Health Partners on a weekly basis. This will be a gentle exercise class for people with chronic pain. While there is no fee for the class, pre-registration is preferred by calling Senior Health Partners at (269) 986-1583. This project was funded by the newly voted in Calhoun County Parks Millage that is shared between Calhoun County and local governments.

Road repair in Leroy Township this summer will include the completion of paving on Capital Avenue S.W.; paver patching and chip and seal applied to 5 Mile Road from M-66 to I Drive South; re-pave of 150' of 4 Mile Road just south of B Drive South; and the crush and re-pave of 2 ½ Mile Road from H Drive South to K Drive South.
